NC ABC Boards Trade Show Memorandum & Registration Form

The North Carolina Association of ABC Boards 2023 General Managers Meeting & Trade Show is scheduled Sunday, March 12 through Tuesday March 14 at the Wilmington Convention Center in Wilmington, NC. The Trade Show is scheduled for the afternoon of Tuesday, March 14 from 3:00 to 5:00pm. We will provide display tables in the Trade Show area for both liquor industry displays and non-liquor displays.

Each company participating must return a signed, completed Trade Show Registration Form (see page 3), a Food & Beverage Sampling Application for Exhibitors (see page 5) and each person participating in the Trade Show must provide their registration information (see page 4) and pay the registration fee for the meeting. We hope to be able to accommodate everyone who wants to display at the Trade Show, but **space is limited so you must register as soon as possible**. There are approximately 80 display tables available. All Trade Show participants must abide by the following rules.

- <u>All</u> participants in the Trade Show must be registered attendees, and all Trade Show participants must wear an NC Association of ABC Boards-issued name tag at all times during the show. <u>No exceptions</u>. <u>Everyone staffing a display table must register and pay the registration fee.</u>
- All distilleries that are represented by a broker in North Carolina must acquire their Trade Show display table space through their NC broker.
- <u>Industry Representatives</u> may only show <u>newly listed items.</u> "Newly listed items" means items listed by the ABC Commission within the past 18 months. In addition, <u>each Division of each Brokerage</u> may show <u>one additional item</u> without regard to whether it qualifies as a "newly listed item."
- You will need to bring your own cups of one ounce or smaller to provide product tastings. All trade show participants requiring ice must bring their own ice chest/bin. The convention center will furnish the ice.
- Trade Show participants must bring their product, displays, back drops, etc., into the convention center through the ground level, loading area.
- You can purchase electrical services at your booth by completing the <u>Convention Center Booth Utility</u> <u>Form</u> to request such services from the convention center. This is an online form; any cost for the electrical service is to be paid for by the exhibitor directly.
- Liquor vendors & representatives may <u>not</u> give attendees "gift" samples (50ml) bottles or advertising novelty items (key chains, t-shirts, bottle openers, hats, visors, etc.). (This is an ABC Commission rule.)

- Only paper print advertising material can be given to attendees. (See above.) The only exception to the rule is the following: <u>Non-liquor</u> exhibitors will be permitted to offer attendees advertising items of nominal value, such as pens, key chains, etc.
- No models (i.e., show-girls or show-boys) will be allowed in the Trade Show.
- The Association will provide snacks for consumption at the Trade Show. No other food items are to be provided at the Trade Show by members of industry or by other exhibitors.
- No spirituous liquor may be served to anyone who is under 21 years of age or who appears to be intoxicated.
- The Association reserves the right to prohibit the use of any unauthorized or objectionable display materials. We encourage the inclusion of social responsibility messaging in your display materials.
- Each Trade Show participant assumes full responsibility for complying with applicable federal, state and local regulations, including those relating to spirituous liquor special events/tastings (NCGS 18B-1114.7).
- No posters or other items may be taped or affixed to any wall or column of the convention center. No balloons, confetti or glitter is permitted in the convention center.
- Each Trade Show participant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the NC Association of ABC Boards and the convention center, and their respective officers, employees and agents, from and against any and all liability (including reasonable attorney fees) arising out of Participant's activities during the Meeting or Trade Show.
- It is understood that all staff (including employees staffing the Trade Show tables) must register and pay the registration fee, and that they must wear Association-issued name badges <u>at all times in the</u> <u>Trade Show area</u>.
- No Trade Show displays may be opened to meeting attendees nor any tastings provided to attendees except during the times authorized for the Trade Show by the NC Association of ABC Boards.
- The NC Association of ABC Boards reserves the right to assign your table location in its discretion.

NEW EVENT ADDED THIS YEAR

New this year we have added a **NC Product Expo and Tasting** to our agenda to highlight local NC products. This event is scheduled for Monday, 3/13/23 from 2:00pm-4:00pm in the Convention Center Ballroom.

If you are a supplier of a NC product, then you are invited to participate as an exhibitor in the NC Product Expo and Tasting on Monday, as well as the Trade Show on Tuesday.

If you are a supplier or broker of a non-NC product or non-liquor product, then you are invited to attend the NC Product Expo and Tasting on Monday, in addition to participating in the Trade Show on Tuesday.

SAVOR...Wilmington has the exclusive food, beverage, and alcohol distribution rights on the Wilmington Convention Center's property. Exhibitors and sponsoring organizations may distribute SAMPLE food and/or beverage products with prior written authorization ONLY.

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

- An exhibitor and/or associate member must occupy approved booths at all times
- Items dispensed are limited to products manufactured, processed, or distributed by exhibiting firm, and must be directly related to participation in event
- Food and/or beverage items used as traffic promoters (i.e., popcorn, coffee, bottled water, etc.) shall be purchased from the Wilmington Convention Center's catering department – contact Mave Claire mclaire@wilmingtonconventions.com
- Food items must be administered and limited to "sampling" or "bite" size portions (1 ounce or less)
- Beverage items must be distributed in containers no greater than 3 ounces, and no more than 2 ounces of product may be distributed per container
- Restrooms, concession stands, and/or facility kitchens may not be used as clean up areas
- There is no space for storage, and/or preparation of product at Wilmington Convention Center
- Costs associated with the disposal of trash, waste, etc. from exhibitor sampling area are the responsibility of the Licensee/Exhibitor
- Exhibitors are not allowed to sell any food and beverage products for consumption at any time during the event

The applicant named below acknowledges they have sole responsibility for use, service, and disposal of such items in compliance with all applicable laws.
